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# 1. Conditions of participation

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## 1.1 National Federations and Organizations that can participate.

Only national federations and organizations regularly affiliated with FISav and CESav in the calendar year of the championship (2023) are entitled to register athletes for the 2023 European Savate Championship.

## 1.2 Official composition of a delegation from each participating country

Each member country in good standing with CESav can register a delegation. It includes a single athlete per weight and gender category, as well as trainers and officials according to the following scale.

Officials	1 – 2 athletes	1 official

	+ 9 athletes	4 officials

The officials must be of the level of the competition and validated by the CESav. If a country is unable to propose the required number of officials, he must inform the CESav when registering his delegation. He will ask a foreign federation to present officials for his delegation.

## 1.3 Registration details

The registration of athletes, trainers, and officials (judges and referees) for the 2023 European Championship is done directly at the secretariat of the European Confederation of Savate : [ces.office@savate-europe.com](mailto:ces.office@savate-europe.com)

### 1.3.1 Pre-registration on 2 registration sheets

For the 2023 European Championship in assault, 2 pre-registrations sheets must be returned to CESav.

- Quantitative registrations before **Friday, June 30, 2023.**

After this date, a country will no longer be able to register an athlete for the European Assault Championship 2023

For ATHLETES: Each participating country completes this form simply to indicate to FISav which categories it will enter athletes into, without giving their names.

For the OFFICIALS AND TRAINERS: These entry forms, signed by the President, must give the full names of each official and trainer who will accompany the athletes, to make the official delegation for the country.

Following this, CESav can inform the organizer of the total number of athletes, officials and trainers who will participate in the European Savate Assaults Championships.

- Nominative registrations **before Friday, July 28, 2023**

Each country must return the completed nominative entry forms to CESav, with the full names of the athletes, and their dates of birth. This nominative registration form must be signed by the President of the national organization. Any change of trainer or official before the competition must be declared to CESav. Without this nominative confirmation of athletes, the country cannot participate in the 2023 European Savate Assaults Championships.

#### **Attention : Delays for VISAS**

The dates above do not consider the delays, variable according to the countries, to obtain visas in the different participating countries.

If these delays are long for certain countries, they must anticipate it and send the names of the participants to CESav early enough to consider these particular delays (monthly August, consulates are sometimes closed). As soon as CESav knows with certainty the names of the people of the delegation, the Organizer will be able to send the invitations for the visas.

#### **Attention : Forfeit (total or partial) by a country that has registered**

If the withdrawal, of part or all from a delegation which is officially registered, is without an acceptable reason, the organizer will have the right to ask this country for compensation of the costs that have been incurred (hotel reservation, meals, etc).

#### **1.3.2 Championship entry fee**

35 euros per athlete and per trainer out of quota, to be paid to the CESav **before Friday July 28, 2023** (date of the nominative registration of the athletes) and 75 euros for the categories not registered on June 30, 2023 (for quantitative registration) .

#### **1.3.3 Age categories**

The European Championships in Assault has a single age category, juniors, seniors, and veterans, for both sexes: athletes over 18 years old (weigh-in day). There can be absolutely no derogation regarding the age of the athletes.

### 1.3.4 Entry rules

Each country can register only one athlete per weight category, age, and gender.

Every athlete must be registered by their national organization, affiliated to CESav. Through this commitment, this organization certifies that it has verified, under its own responsibility, the age, the weight, and the medical aptitude, as well as the technical and sporting level of the athletes for this form of competition in Assaults.

The criteria of national selection are left to the national Savate organization of the participating countries.

The athletes must be insured by their respective national organization against all possible damage that could occur on this competition.

At the time of the registration, each country will designate, **among the trainers, a head of delegation** who will be the spokesman for his country with CESav and the organizer. The head of delegation will have all power of decision over the athletes or trainers of his delegation.

A substitute, of the same weight and age category, may be designated at the time of the nominative registration (before Friday, June 30, 2023). He may then, if necessary, join the competition according to the following procedures: during the weigh-in before the start of the competition.

If the athlete officially designated by his country is absent, the substitute must then be presented by the head of delegation.

As soon as the weigh-in and the medical check have been carried out, the substitute becomes the athlete officially representing his country in his category.

The absent official athlete, who had been foreseen at the time of registration, is then definitively eliminated from this competition.

### 1.3.5 License and Nationality

Reminder: Volume II - Rules of Procedure of FISav adopted by the general assembly of October 02, 2005 in Paris (France), modified by the general assembly of the FISav of Thursday 30 October 2014 in Rome (Italy) *Article 11 - § 2: International Competitors: License and Nationality*

## 2. Technical rules

### 2.1 Form of the bouts in Assault

All assaults (eliminations and finals) are conducted in a ring **complying with the regulations** of CESav in Assault.

- Assaults will be 3 rounds de 2 minutes each (**5 judges for Finals**)

### 2.2 Weight categories and Gloves

**For men:** a sole weight category for those who weigh less than 56 kg and a sole weight category for those who weigh more than 85kg.

**For women:** a sole weight category for those who weigh less than 48kg and a sole weight category for those who weigh more than 75 kg.

### 2.3 Protections – equipment

Athletes must be in possession of their equipment, which must comply with the texts of the CESav.

The equipment must be in good condition and in compliance with CESav regulations.

A general equipment check will take place for each athlete.

Each athlete must be in possession of a pair of gloves in good condition and in accordance with the weight category in which he is engaged.

**Warning :** some shoes (too hard) do not comply with Assault ethics (no intentional injuries). For this competition, savate shoes must be flexible enough to match this spirit of the assault. Likewise, the size and shape of the headguards must be adapted to this competition.

The General Official Delegate will refuse any equipment that does not correspond to the savate criteria. His decision is final.

**Reminder :** In assault, each athlete is free to put on a helmet and shin guards, or not to put any, regardless of the opponent.

## 2.4 Weigh-in

Weigh-in is mandatory before the competition for all participating athletes. The weight athletes must match the registration category.

Each athlete is entitled to 3 weigh-ins to correspond to their weight category, within the time limit provided for the weigh-in (FISav regulations).

## 2.5 Medical check up

**2.5.1 For assault competitions,** certain preliminary medical examinations are mandatory for all participating athletes. These examinations are those provided for by the FISav medical regulations. These preliminary examinations are the responsibility of each national organization of Savate and are carried out in the country of the athlete.

### 2.5.2 The national organization that made the registrations certifies

- That he has checked under his sole responsibility, the medical fitness of each athlete entered for this type of assault competition and that he has undergone in his country the examinations provided for by the regulations of the CESav.
- That each athlete is insured for bodily injury that may be caused during the competition. The registration of an athlete engages the responsibility of the participating federation or national body.

**2.5.3 Before the start of the competition,** a check of the medical aptitude document is obligatorily carried out by a qualified doctor, designated by the organizer. This doctor can decide on the spot of the incapacity of an athlete. Its decision is sovereign and without appeal.

**2.5.4 As FISav is a member of the World Anti-Doping Agency (AMA),** if an anti-doping control in accordance with AMA rules takes place during the competition, no athlete can avoid it. In case of refusal, the athlete is eliminated from the competition. Anti-doping control can take place before, during or after the competition. The costs of the anti-doping control will be paid by the organizer.

## 2.6 Course of the competition

### 2.6.1 Prerequisites control

After the weigh-in and medical check-up, the General Official Delegate draws up the final list of athletes, men, and women, present in each category, based on the nominative entries sent by each country to CESav. It may take substitute athletes into account.

If an athlete, after weighing and medical control, does not correspond to his registration category, the General Official Delegate examines whether it is nevertheless possible to integrate him, on an exceptional basis, into the competition, in the interest sporty of it and with a concern for fairness. The decision of the General Official Delegate is sovereign and without appeal.

### 2.6.2 Competition rules

- The playoffs take place primarily in the form of qualifying tournament. However, if the number of registered in a weight category is too large, the General Official Delegate (DOG) may decide to favor the solution by direct elimination. In this case, he will first inform all the delegations of the weight category concerned.
- The rules of the assault are those provided for by the regulations of the Federation International of Savate for assault competitions.

### 2.6.3 Results of qualifying tournament, semi-finals, and finals.

The qualifying tournament matches allow the four semi-finalists in each category to be selected.

In the qualifying tournament elimination system, the following scale is applied:

Results	Points
Victory	3
Defeat	1
Equality	2
Flat rate	- 1
Disqualification	- 3

In the event of an equality between two athletes at the end of the group, the winner will be determined according to the following order of preference:

1. The winner of the assault that opposed them.
2. The athlete who will have received the fewest warnings during all their assaults.
3. The one with the most wins.
4. The lightest at the time of weighing.
5. Draw



In any case, before an assault, any athlete must first report to the official delegate of the ring before the start of the assault (even if the athlete wishes to forfeit the assault in question). If an athlete does not show up for an assault, he is declared as having definitively abandoned the championship, by the DOG of the CESav

No title can be awarded to an athlete if he has not completed at least one assault during the championship.

## **2.7 Complaints about decisions** (CDI FISav December 14, 2003, resolution 16<sup>th</sup>)

In the event of a disputed decision, only **the head of delegation** has the right **to file a written complaint using the specific form.**

However, this principle must respect the following precise rules:

- The head of the delegation, who lodges the protest, must not have been one of the officials (judge or referee) of the assault whose decision is contested.
- The complaint must be substantiated and filed with the official delegate of the ring concerned no later than 15 minutes after the proclamation of the contested decision.
- To be admissible, and therefore taken into consideration, this complaint must only relate to breaches of the rules of the competition, and not to the contestation of an assessment of the value of the athletes by the officials.

A complaints committee, made up of the general official delegate and the rings delegates, will decide on the complaint in the time necessary for the smooth running of the competition. His decision will be final, the opinion of the DOG of the CESav being preponderant in the event of a tie.

## **2.8 Unforeseen situations**

In case of disagreement about a situation not explicitly provided for in these regulations, the Sports Director of CESav, if present, is informed. Then an interpretation committee decides, and its decision is final. This interpretation committee includes at least 3 different countries. It is made up of the General Official Delegate, the official rings delegates and 2 people designated by the general General Official Delegate, from among the members of the delegations present. In case of shared opinions, that of the General Official Delegate is preponderant.

## 3. Financial conditions

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### 3.1 Charges borne by the organizer.

Unless otherwise agreed in writing with CESav, the organizer provides all the environment and sports equipment necessary for an international Savate competition, concerning for example: the hall, speakers, scales, gongs, stopwatches, etc. , and in accordance with FISav regulations. The organizer also provides a control and medical care service.

Finally, the organizer will provide transport for the national delegations between their places of arrival (airport, train station – the closest), the place of accommodation and catering, and the place of the competition.

#### 3.1.1 The athletes :

The organizer will support only one athlete per weight and gender category.

#### 3.1.2 The main trainers

The number of main trainers supported by the organizer will be limited according to the following scale, by country:

#### 3.1.3 Officials

Each national delegation must, obligatorily, propose a number of officials according to the following scale:

athletes	Officials
1 à 2	1
3 à 5	3
6 à 9	4

After the final registration (nominative, before July 28) of the officials, according to the number of registered officials and the necessary number of officials for the competition, the CESav reserves the right to refuse officials on the principle of limiting the costs of the organizer. They will be informed by the CESav in August. However, non-accepted officials wishing to participate may do so, but at their own expense.

A country can ask another country to provide it with the compulsory officials (decision of the FISav CDI of December 14, 2003). If that a country is unable to provide the compulsory officials designated by the scale above, it is required to inform the CESav when registering its delegation. In case of a solution does not found, the CESav reserves the right to reduce the number of athletes entered according to the number of officials presented.

### Airport hotel shuttle and hotel shuttle to the competition venue (round trip)

#### 3.1.4 The General Official Delegate and the Sportif Delegate

The organizer pays for their stay (meals and accommodation) for the duration necessary for the organization of the competition, as well as hotel airport shuttles and hotel shuttles to the competition venue (round trip).

#### 3.1.5 Excluded expenses (see 3.2.4 before)

No other expense, made by the participants (athletes, officials, or trainers) will be supported by the organizer.

### 3.2 Charges borne by participating countries.

#### 3.2.1 Travel expenses

The travel expenses (round trip) of all the members of the delegation (athletes, trainers, head of delegation, officials) are borne by the participating nations.

#### 3.2.2 Registration fees

**Athlete registration fees are paid directly to CESav, they amount to 35 euros per athlete, before July 28, 2023, by bank transfer to the account:**

### 3.2.3 Accommodation and catering costs for athletes and trainers

For the 2023 European Championship, a financial contribution to accommodation and catering costs is requested for each athlete and each trainer who wishes to benefit from the organization provided by the organizer, for the entire duration of the competition ( not for officials, judges, referees, DOG appointed by the CESav). It is:

The CESav and the organizer must be informed of the arrival of any person additional in each official national delegation. After agreement between CESav and the organizer, the national delegation of a country will fully cover the accommodation and catering costs of the additional people accompanying this delegation.

**The financial participation of athletes, trainers and additional officials must be paid to the organizer before Tuesday August 1, 2023.**

### 3.2.4 The head of delegation

A head of delegation is appointed by the national organization of Savate, affiliated to the CESav, from among the main trainers. **If the head of delegation is not a trainer, he is not part of the official delegation AND WILL NOT BE COVERED** by the organizer for accommodation and catering.

There is only one head of delegation per participating delegation. He is the interlocutor of the CESav (General Official Delegate and/or Sports Delegate) and of the Organizer for his country.

The head of delegation must contact the organizer in writing (fax, email, letter) no later than 2 weeks before the start of the competition, to inform him of the mode of transport used by his delegation, the place of arrival (airport, station, etc.) of the day and time.

After this date, the organizer is no longer required to support the reception of the delegation concerned, which must reach the place of the competition by its own means.

### 3.2.5 Additional expenses of the participants in the championship

Any expense **not provided** for in the expenses of the organizer (see previous art. 3.1) **must be paid immediately** (in euros or legal currency of the host country) by the person who incurred it, or by his head of delegation (for example : bar drinks, hotel or restaurant supplements, etc.).

### 3.2.5 Recommendation

To avoid any regrettable mistake by the organizer, it is recommended that each delegation come with the flag of its country (maximum size: 1 m x 1.50 m) and its national anthem.

## 3.3 Expenses supported by the European Confederation of Savate

**3.3.1 The CESav will appoint and take responsibility** for the entire duration of the competition.

- The travel expenses of the General Official Delegate (DOG) of CESav and the Sports Delegate.

**3.3.2 CESav will receive and register registrations from each affiliated country** and the composition of each national delegation. It will communicate them to the organizer and to the General Official Delegate of the European Confederation of Savate. This one, with the help of the official enclosure delegates, will organize the assaults of the championship in the respect and the application of all the regulations of the CESav.

### 3.3.3 The diplomas

Each athlete participating in the 2023 European Championship will receive a certificate or diploma from the European Confederation of Savate for their participation in the competition.

The winners of the championship, their finalists, as well as the semi-finalists, will receive a medal and a specific diploma, awarded by CESav.

The winner of the competition obtains the gold medal and the title of "**Champion d'Europe de Savate Assauts 2023**" in the weight category concerned.

The loser of the final obtains the silver medal and the title of "**Finaliste du Championnat d'Europe de Savate Assaut 2023**" in the weight category concerned.

The 2 losers of the semi-finals will be awarded the title of "**Médaille de bronze du Championnat d'Europe de Savate Assaut 2023**" in the weight category concerned. This will be provided by the organizer.

**No title can be awarded to an athlete if he has not made at least one effective assault during the Championship.**
